The changes are as follows and will necessitate an update to our Constitution.

From 1 July 2024, incorporated associations must:

- disclose remuneration paid and any benefits given to committee members, senior staff and their relatives at their Annual General Meeting
- *follow the* grievance procedure in the model rules *to resolve disputes or include a compliant grievance procedure in their own rules.*

Our current Grievance Procedure is no longer compliant; therefore we must submit our amended constitution to the Office of Fair Trading by **30 April 2024** to allow sufficient time for them to review and register it.

The Office of Fair Trading advises that these changes may be implemented through a general meeting, which was held this morning.

NAB Administration Issues

The committee also discussed the ongoing problems with NAB at the meeting, specifically the inability of NAB to accurately record current signatories or remove obsolete signatories.
