Please come and join us for these fun events that the Social Committee organise for us.

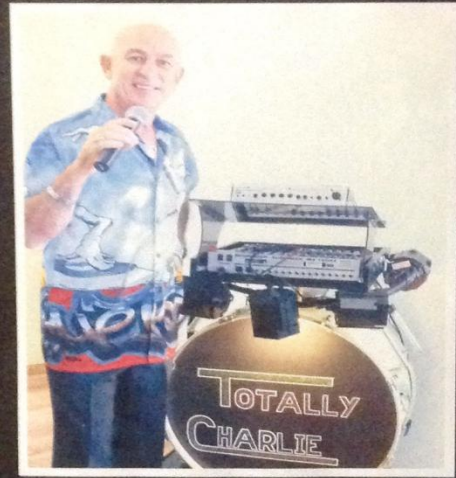
